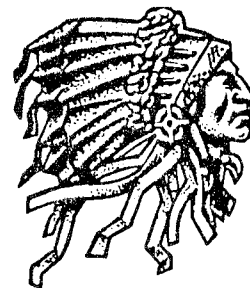

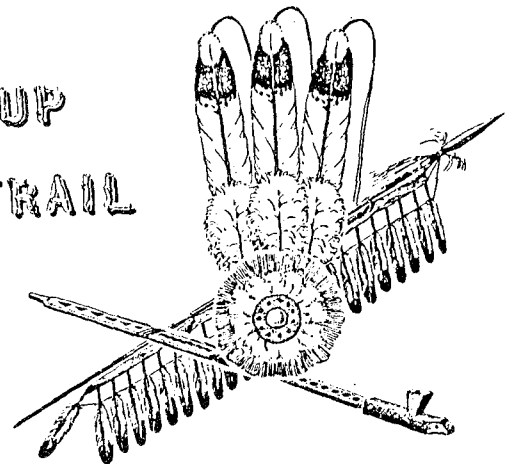
For a mere \$475.00 you can attend. Signups are being taken on a first come first served basis and registration sheets are now available. Participation is somewhat limited.

Only 10 from the lodge can attend. Chapters who believe that one or more of their members should be considered should contact the Lodge Chief at 292-4835.

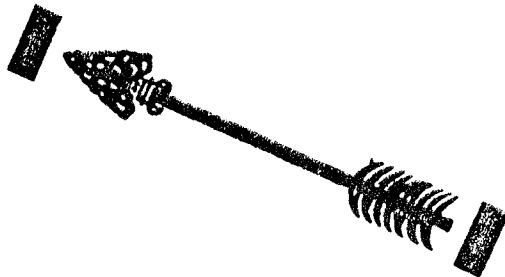
