3 1/2 YARDS OF 36" MATERIALS IS ENOUGH FOR SIZES UP TO 16 OR 17

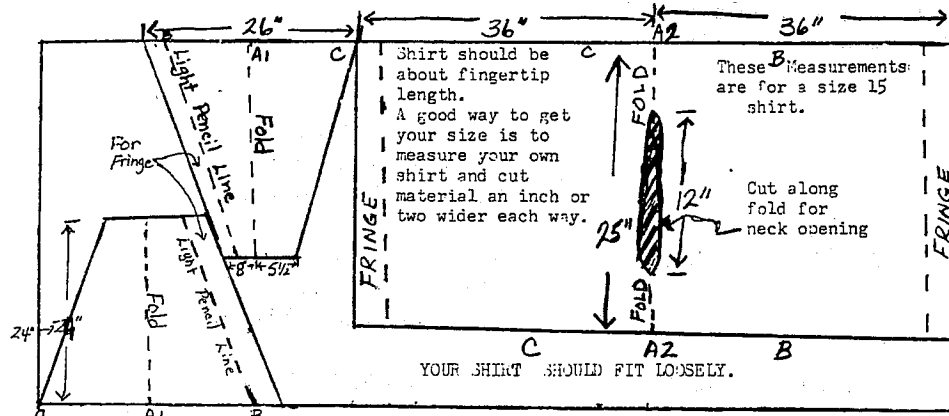
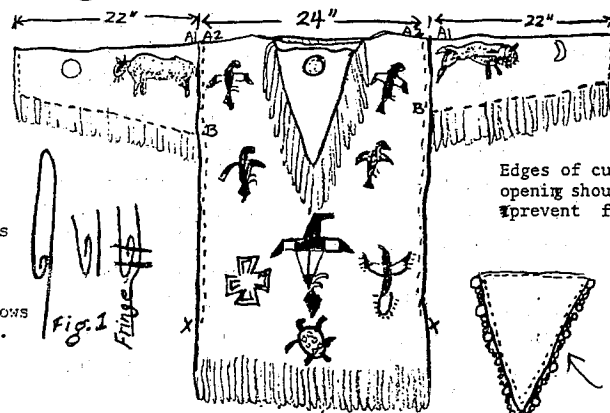


Fig. 1 shows how to sew bottom seam of sleeve, using two rows of stitches.

Fig. 1 Fringe



Edges of cuffs and neck opening should be hemmed to prevent fraying.

The back and front of the shirt is decorated quite similar.

Triangular neckpiece with beaded edge.

Sew shirt sleeve B to C.. Match sleeve head A1 to shirt head A2, and sew. Then sew shirt B to C. Cut fringe 1/2" wide with scissors, cutting with the weave and not at an angle. DO NOT CUT FRINGE ON SHIRT BOTTOM OR SLEEVES UNTIL SHIRT IS COMPLETELY MADE.

GOULASH

Will make enough for 8 boys.

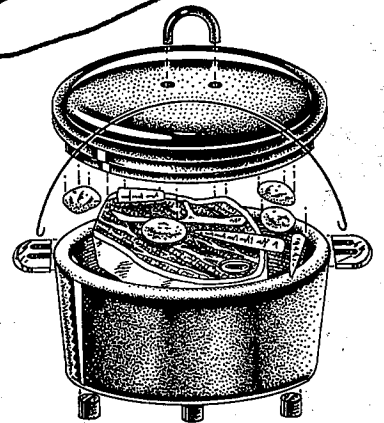
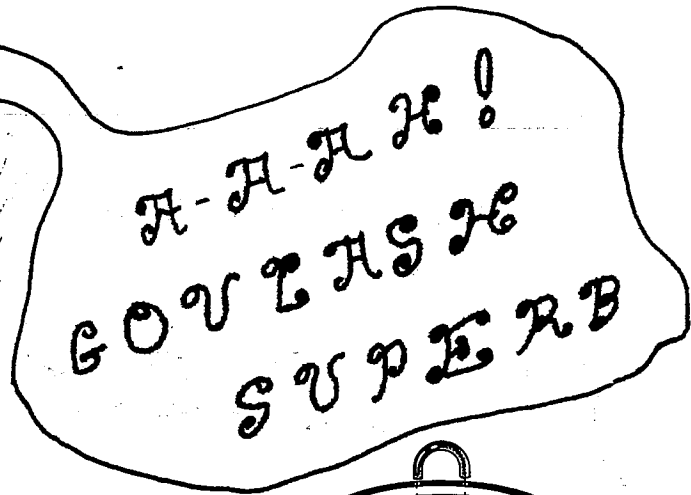
- 1 pound macaroni
- 2 pounds hamburger
- 6- 8 oz. cans tomato sauce
- 2- 17 oz. cans whole kernel corn
- 1 tablespoon soup green (Schillings)
- 1/2 cup sugar

Put 4 quarts of water on to boil and add 1/4 tsp. salt. When the water comes to a boil, add macaroni. Stir occasionally to keep from sticking (approximately 20 mins.). Cook until soft, but not mushy.

While macaroni is cooking, put 1 tbsp. cooking oil in frying pan and cook 1 pound at a time. (Add a little onion and garlic salt) When hamburger is cooked, drain off grease and set aside.

When macaroni is cooked, combine macaroni, sauce, corn, hamburger and seasonings.

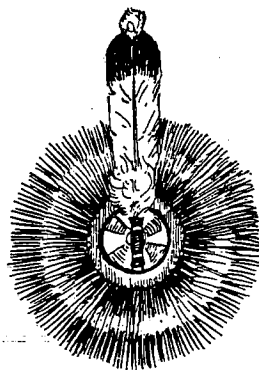
