



If any of you Arrowmen would like to help with the completition on the Lodge, please call Eli Preston, 968-9711, He is correlating the work on the Lodge at present.

We still need lots of help and will be calling chapters and asking for your help and support on this work project to complete it.





3½ YANDS OF 36" MATURIALS IS EMOUGH FOR SIZES UP TO 16 OR 17



Sew shirt sleeve B to C.. Match sleeve
head Al to Shirt head A2, and sew. Then sew shirt
B to C. Cut fringe ½" wide with scissors,
cutting with the weave and not at an angle. DO NOT CUT
FRINGE ON SHIRT BOTTOM OR SLEEVES UNTIL SHIRT IS COMPLETELY MADE.





1 pound macaroni
2 pounds hamburger
6-8 oz. cans tomato sauce

2- 17 oz. cans whole kernel corn 1 tablespoon soup green (Schillings) 1/2 cup sugar

Put 4 quarts of water on to boil and add 1/4 tsp. salt. When the water comes to a boil, add macoroni. Stir occasionally to keep from sticking (approximately 20 mins.). Cook until soft, but not mushy.

While macoroni is cooking, put 1 tbsp. cooking oil in frying pan and cook 1 pound at a time. (Add a little onion and garlic salt) When hamburger is cooked, drain off grease and set aside.

When macoroni is cooked, combine macaroni, sauce, corn, hamburger and seasonings.


