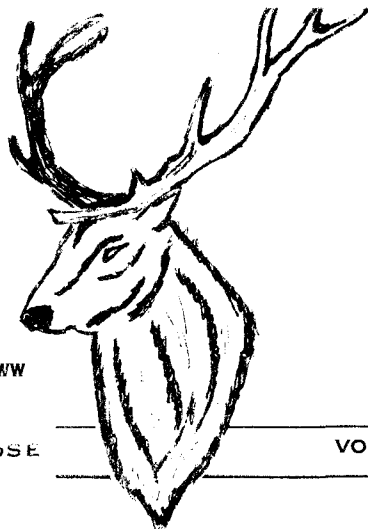

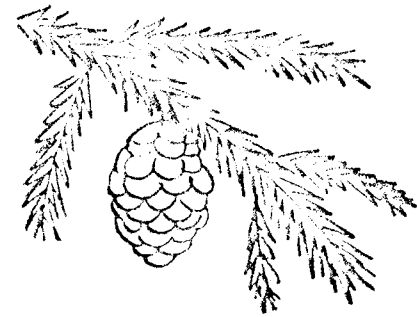
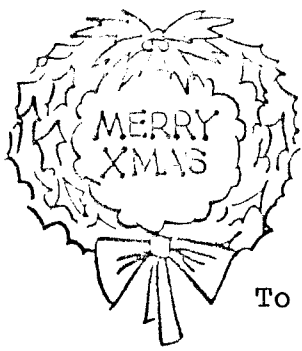

## CHANCE OF A LIFETIME

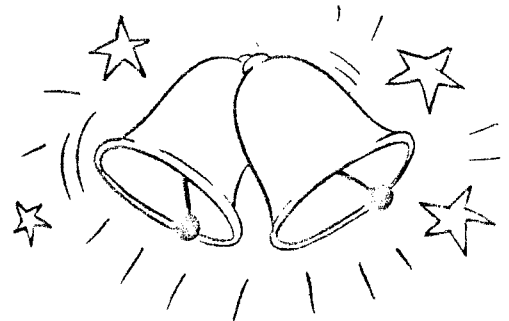
Maane Hermansen, won the last secret arrowman contest. The answer was Virgil Christensen.

## LODGE PATCH

The so called "Kissing Elk" lodge flap was produced in 1984 and used primarily for the 1984 and Spring 1985 ordeals. The issue was limited to 1500 patches and purchased from International Emblem.

In July of 1985 the Lodge produced a 12 color patch as the official patch denoted by the arrow having a black tip and feathers. The issue was limited to 1000 pieces and made overseas.

In August of 1985 the 12 color patch was modified to increase the colors in the sky with the addition of a soft red and yellow and the arrow was changed to all red. 1000 pcs. were ordered in August.

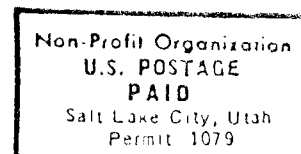
