That's just about the nicest news you could get!!

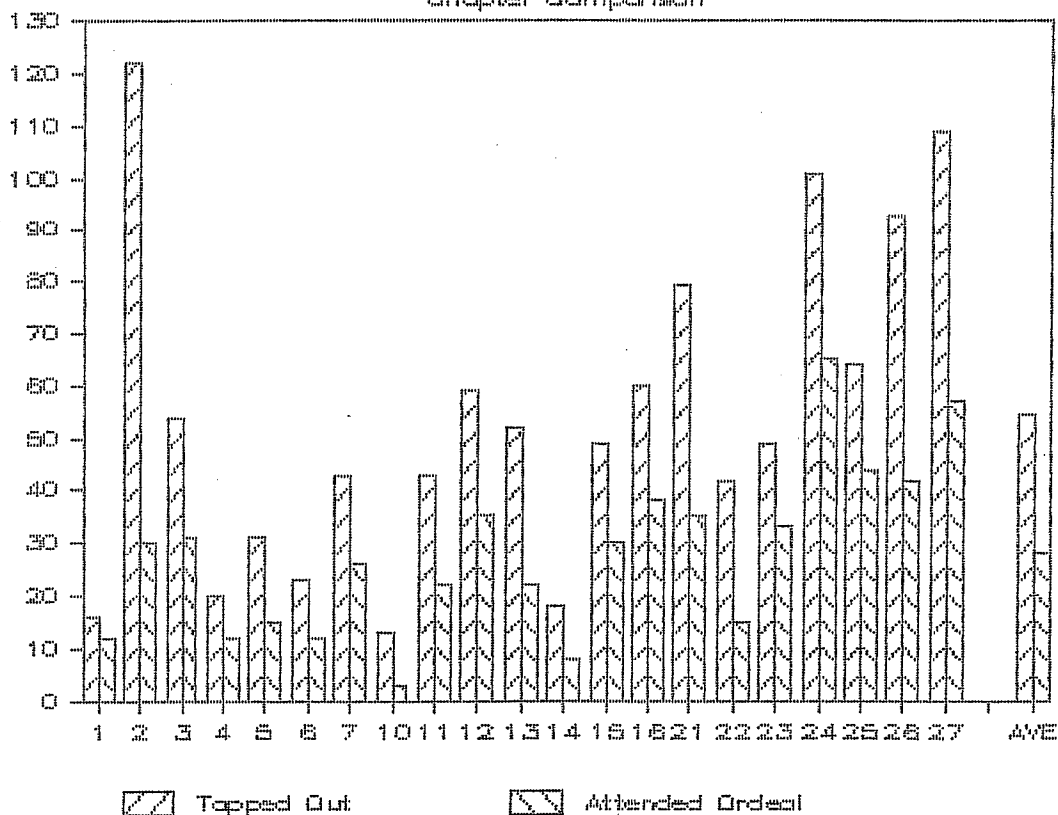
## A SPECIAL DINNER

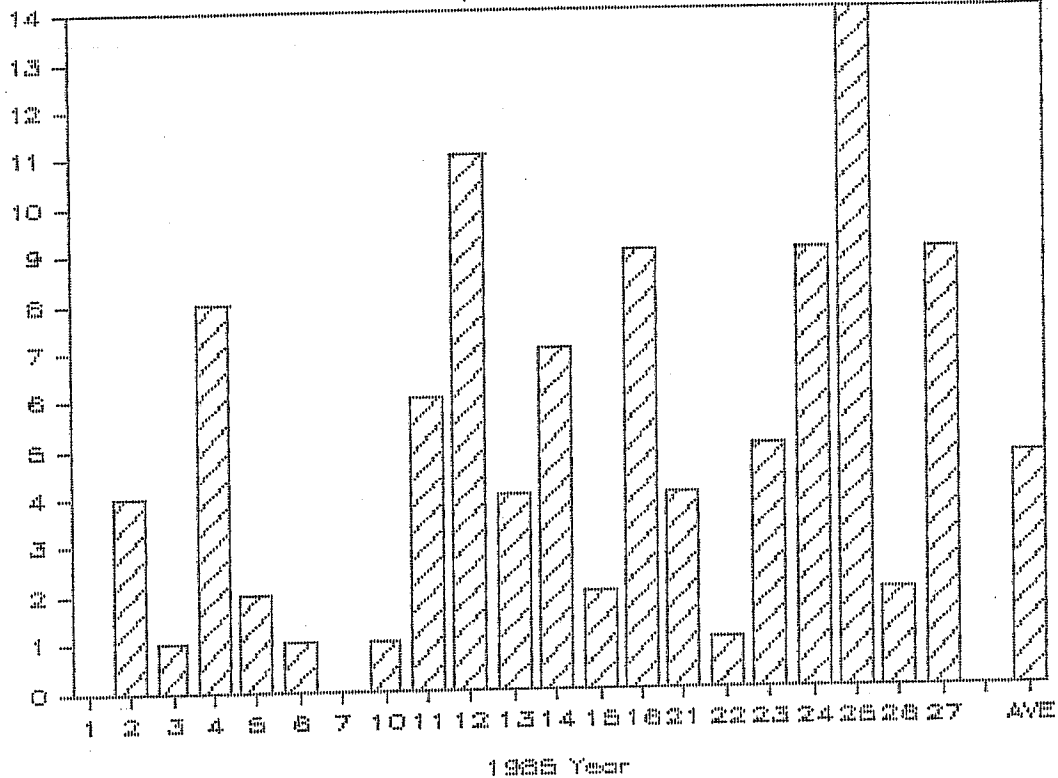
## EL-KU-TA LODGE ELECTION & ORDEALS

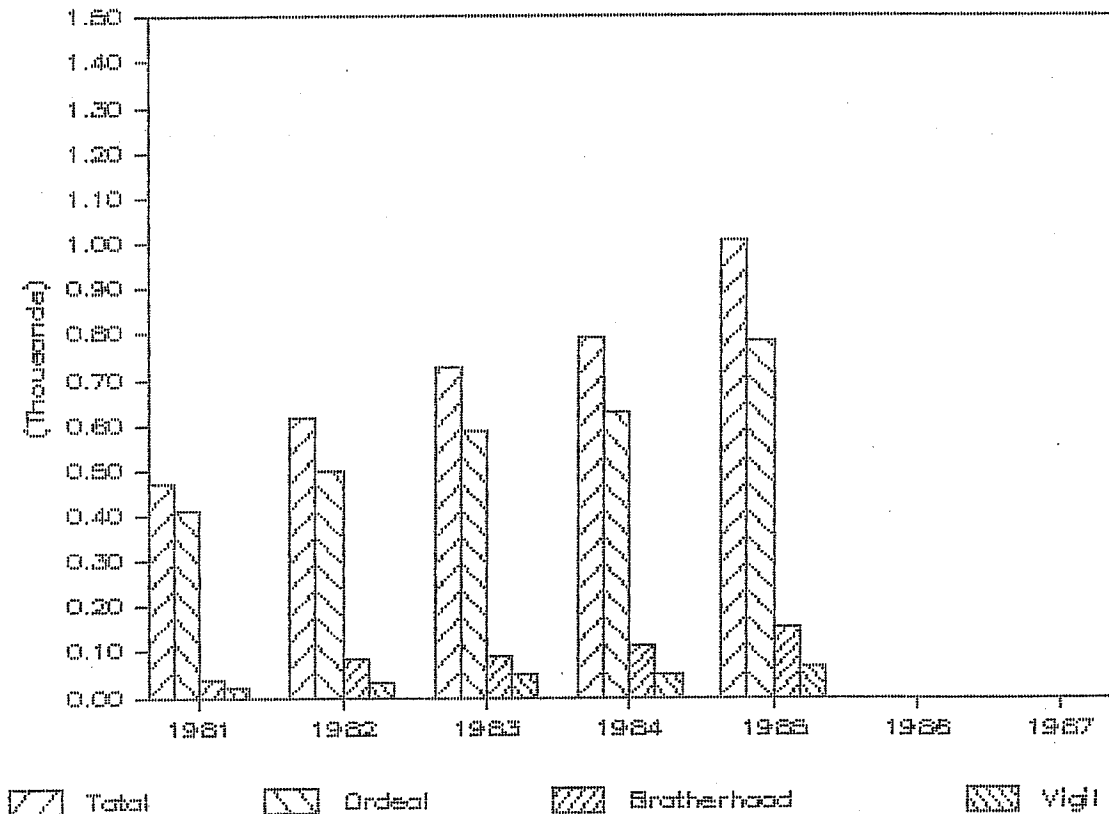

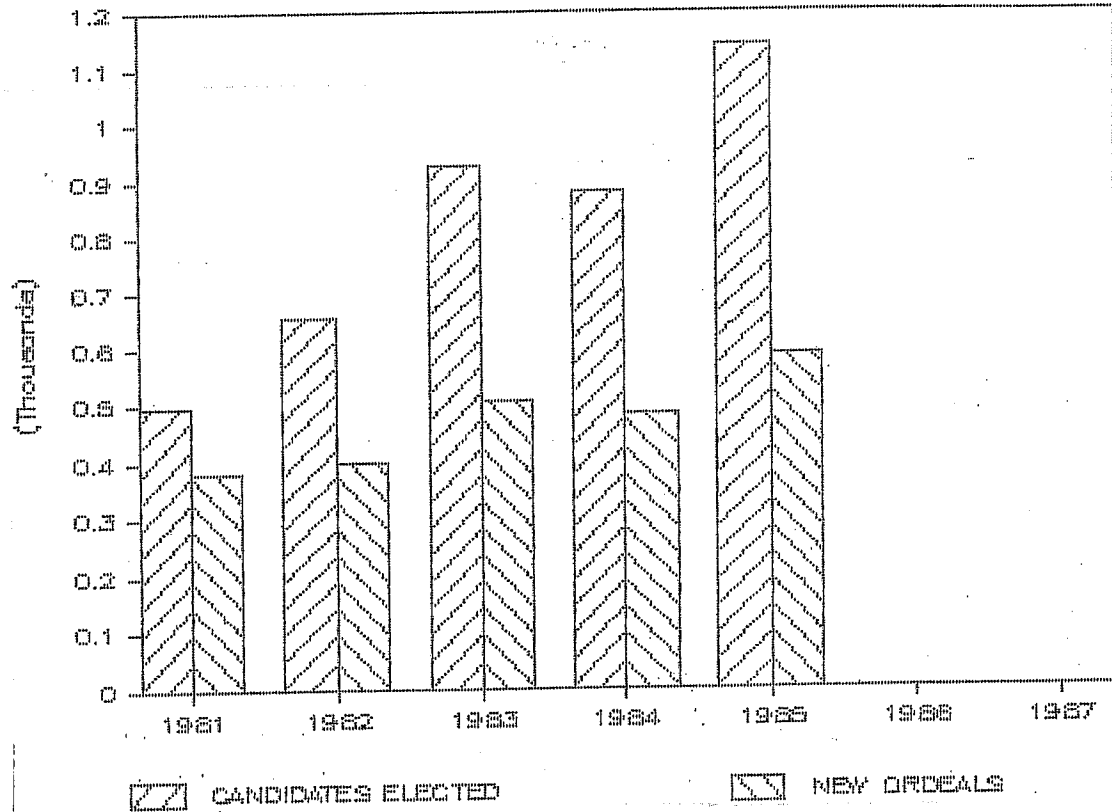

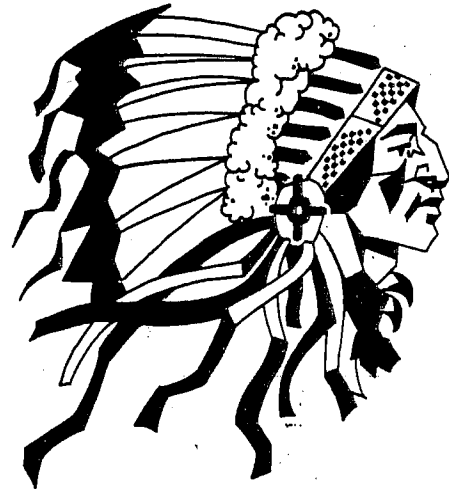
## DANCING AWAY

### MACHQUE #25

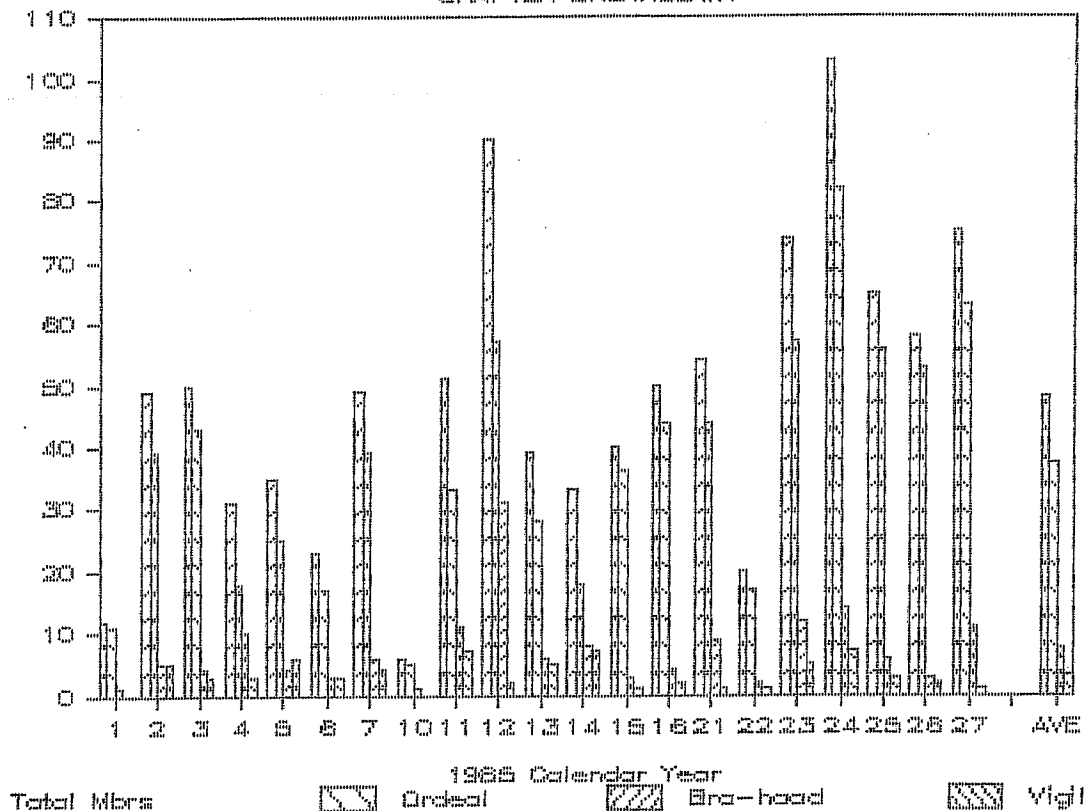
