

TUMMY TICKLERS

DUTCH OVEN CHICKEN

Put enough briquets on the ground to cover the underneath bottom of a dutch oven. Place the dutch oven on the briquets.

Put 1/8" of cooking oil in the dutch oven. When oil is hot, rinse the cut up chicken with water—then dip in flour and put in oil. Brown three pieces at a time in the hot oil. When the chicken pieces are browned, place them on an upside down dutch oven lid that has about 6 briquets under it to keep the chicken warm.

When all the pieces are browned, put them back in the dutch oven and add enough water to cover chicken 2/3 of the way. Put lid on the dutch oven. Keep good heat under the dutch oven and about 8 briquets on top of the lid and cook about 35 minutes or until meat falls away from the bone. Chicken is done.

Two chickens will serve about 8 people.




