Projects such as repairing the firebowl to a permanent one, setting up parts of camp, and painting things will be done. The summer fellowships in the past have been fun, but after we had the new members we usually just sat around. We will have the waterfront open to those who can pass the swim check. If, for some reason, you can't find a car pool and you can't get a ride from your parents, call your chapter chief and possibly he can help you. It also wouldn't hurt to pitch in for gas if your parents aren't driving.

This fellowship will be something that you won't forget, and neither will the camp. Try to make it, and get your friends to come also.
