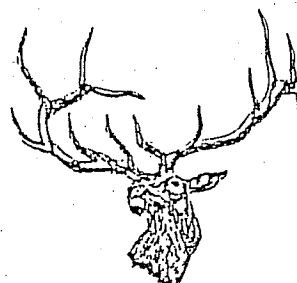

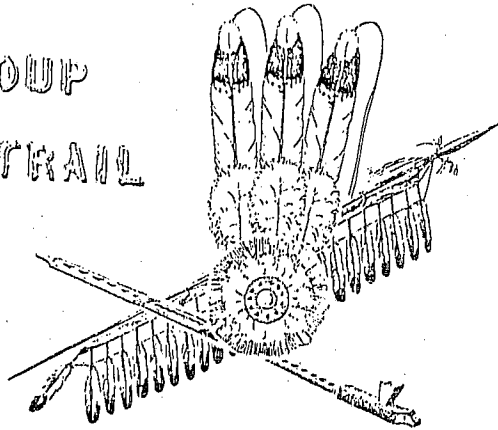

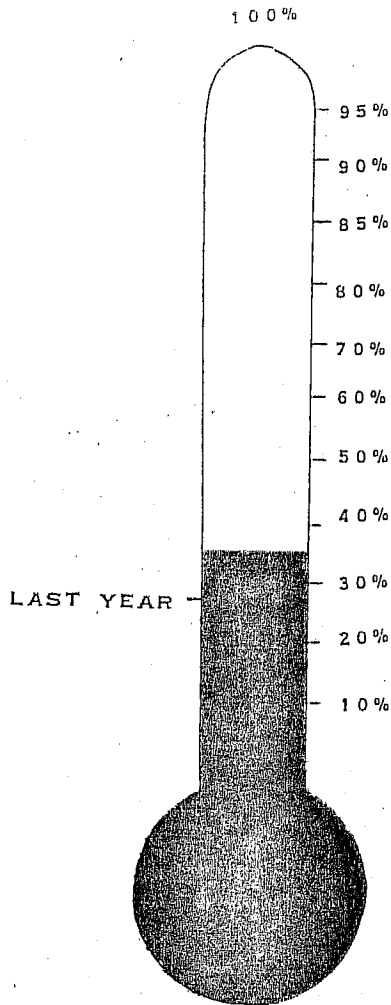

### BY-LAW CHANGES

At the last LECM the officer agreed to make the following changes in the Lodge By-Laws.

A Senior Vice Chief will be appointed from among the elected Vice Chief by the Lodge Chief.

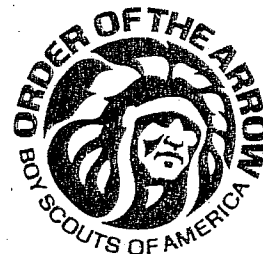

The duties of the Ceremonies Vice Chief will be handled by the Senior Vice Chief.

There will no longer be a Treasurer of the Lodge. The duties of the treasurer will be added to those of the Lodge Secretary and the title will be that of Lodge Secretary.

## SILVER ELK (#24)

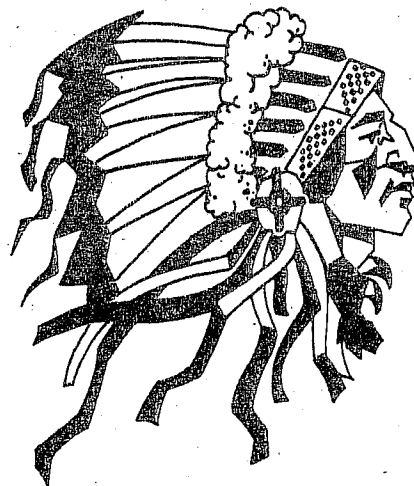

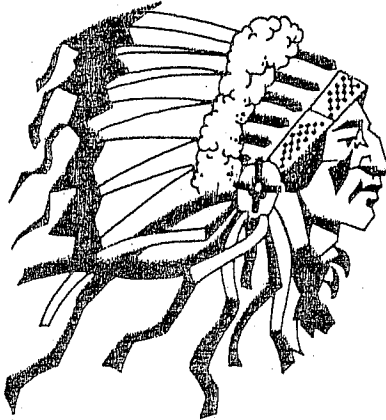

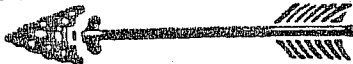
