Announced at the 1981 national Order of the Arrow conference, the ten commemorative medals honoring Dr. E. Urner Goodman, Col. Carroll A. Edson and significant events in the history of the Order are being distributed as minted.

The first two medals have been received and are being distributed.

The third medal has been ordered and distribution will begin within 6-8 weeks.

The attractive 9" X 12" walnut plaque is being shipped to those Arrowmen who are participating in the complete program.

Lodges as well as individual Arrowmen are using this commemorative medal program to help in the creation of historical data for the lodge as well as participate in the building of the Order of the Arrow trust fund.

The Order of the Arrow trust fund has reached the level that will permit the announcement of the details of E. Urner Goodman Scholarship program to be made this May.
