

- Winnebago Tube Chocker Kit -

(1) - First, read through the instructions carefully and visualize in your mind how each step fits into the project. Then follow the instructions carefully step-by-step to complete a quality finished chocker.

(2) - As in Figure 1, the latigo leather must be cut into 4 pieces. Each piece, or spacer, should measure $3/8$ " wide by $1\ 3/8$ " long.

(3) - Punch 4 holes, as shown, in each spacer. Make sure these holes are evenly spaced on the leather and that all are in the same place on each spacer.

(4) - Tie the imitation sinew securely through the top hole on one spacer and then string: 1 bead, 1 tube, 3 beads, 1 tube, 1 bead, one spacer, 1 bead, 1 tube, 3 beads, 1 tube, 1 bead, one spacer, 1 bead, 1 tube, 3 beads, 1 tube, 1 bead and then the last spacer.

(5) - Holding everything together, put the chocker around your neck and test for length. If it's too short, you're all right. If it's too long (make sure you've got room to tie it), you can leave out beads or even tubes to make sure it will fit!

(6) - Now, without cutting the imitation sinew, tie this row securely to the last spacer, thread the sinew through the next hole down and repeat the sequence you used above.

(7) - Tie this row into place and continue stringing in sequence until you have completed the four rows.

(8) - Cut the thong into two pieces and tie one piece to each end placing it between the second and third rows on the last spacer, or end piece. You should have four beads left over and you have these to decorate the thong by stringing them and then tying a knot.

(9) - The chocker is now complete. Wear with pride and enjoyment!

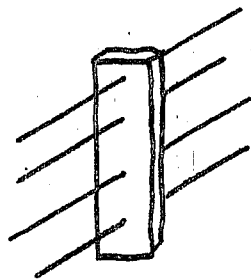
