

EAGLE BADGE PRESENTATION

Eagle Nest is formed at the beginning of Court of Honor

Escort Scouts to be at rear of room

Master of Ceremonies:

Will the candidate and his parents, and Scoutmaster please stand.

Scout, parents and Scoutmaster to be escorted to the front, boy to be centered with parents on each side, with Scoutmaster to the rear. Escort Scouts to enter nest and stay standing until end of presentation.

VOICE OF READER: Eagle candidate(s) _____ I charge you to enter this Eagle Brotherhood, holding without reservation ever before you the ideals of honor and service. By the repeating of the Eagle Scout promise before your fellow members you will become an Eagle Scout, though the words you use will be similar to those by which you joined Scouting, tonight they will mean more than they could have meant at any other time in the past. When you pledge yourself on your honor, you will be sealing your eternal loyalty to the code of the Eagle Scout, with the words which closed the Declaration of Independence.

VOICE OF READER: Eagle Candidate, Scout sign make, please repeat after me.

I _____, reaffirm my allegiance/ to the three promises of the Scout Oath/ I recognize and take upon myself/ the obligations and responsibilities/ of the rank of Eagle Scout/ on my honor I will do my best/ to make my training an example/to exemplify better Scouting and better citizenship/ in my Troop and in my community/ and in my contact with other people/ to this I pledge my sacred honor. (two)

VOICE OF READER: By the authority vested in me by the National Court of Honor of the Boy Scouts of America, it is my privilege and pleasure to pronounce you an Eagle Scout, may the oath you have taken remain engraven on your heart forever.

VOICE OF READER: In recognition of fatherly advice and guidance along the trail, your father holds your Eagle Badge, no one will ever know the unnumbered acts of self sacrifice and helpfulness that has made this presentation possible.

VOICE OF READER: Will the father or mother pin the badge on the new Eagle.

VOICE OF READER: The new Eagle will present a miniature to the mother.

MASTER OF CERMONIES: Present Eagle card, letter from National, and other material as required.

VOICE OF READER: Will the Eagle now escort his parents to their seats, then come forward to be presented to the nest.

(Scoutmaster to join court at rear at this time)

VOICE OF READER: I suggest the members of the Eagle Nest be the first to congratulate the new member, who will carry on the traditions of those who have gone before him.

(Present Eagle neckerchief)

MASTER OF CEREMONIE* Have boy join nest, turn time back to court officials.
