CHAPER UNIT ELECTIONS

COMPLETE THESE STEPS FOR SUCCESSFUL UNIT ELECTIONS THIS YEAR.

- 1. Get a list of unit and phone numbers from the Lodge Elections Chairman should be available at the November LECM.
- 2. Find out which unit needs to have an election.
- 3. Have an adult adviser contact the unit leader, explain about the OA if necessary and set up the date for the election.
- 4. If the unit does not desire an election, turn in a report after the phone contact indicating so.
- 5. All units are to be contacted by December 15th.
- 6. Have an election team show up on the date of the election and
 - a. Promote the summer camps of the council
 - b. Hold the election
 - c. Get a unit representative if possible.
- 7. After the election take the candidates into another room and go over the ordeal dates and times. Each candidate is to fill out the Ordeal registration.
- 8. The candidate takes home the "white" copy of the registration.
- 9. The "yellow" copy of the registration is to be attached to the unit election form and turned into the scout office as soon as possible after the election.
- 10. The "pink" copy of the form is to be left with the chapter elections committee.
- 11. Schedule a candidate orientation meeting for an early March/April date or invite candidates to participate in chapter meetings.
